Abstract

Zblbuild is a shell + GUI script designed to make the choice of Biblatex styles and options easier. The script generates either a LaTeX or a Markdown - YAML snippet. The script has been tested only on a Linux platform, but should work on any platform running bash + zenity.

1 Dependencies

The programme requires a bash shell and zenity version 3.xx. Zenity is a GTK+ lightweight tool – standard in most Linux distributions – that outputs message windows, error windows and the like. See https://help.gnome.org/users/zenity/stable/.

2 Installation

From a terminal:

- 1. download zblbuild-o1c.zip
- 2. cd to the Downloads folder
- 3. unzip zblbuild-01c.zip
- 4. cd zblbuild-01c
- 5. sudo ./install enter your username when required
- 6. run the script from the desktop icon or from the command line

If wished, edit the paths in the install file and run install, or manually copy the files to your preferred locations.

3 Usage

Simply run the program. At the end, copy and paste the output to your ET_EX or Markdown file.

4 Uninstallation

Run unistall script: sudo ./uninstall - enter your username when required

5 Bugs and TODO
